1. These Horse Trials will be conducted under the E.F.A. Combined Training Rules for Horse Trials.
2. **LIABILITY:** Neither the Organising Committee nor the Equestrian Federation of Australia, nor the Owners of the Property, accept any liability for accident, damage, injury or illness to riders, spectators or any person or property whatsoever.
3. **RESERVATION:** The organisers reserve the right—
 - (a) to cancel any class or event
 - (b) to divide any class
 - (c) to alter the advertised times
 - (d) to refuse any entry, with or without reason
 - (e) to combine any classes.
4. **FORBIDDEN ASSISTANCE:** Outside assistance is forbidden, under penalty of elimination. Any intervention by a third party, whether solicited or not, considered forbidden assistance.
Catching a loose horse, helping the rider adjust his saddlery, or to remount after a fall, is permitted.
5. **PRESENTATION OF PRIZES:** The Prize-Giving will take place at the conclusion of the Endurance Phase on Sunday, 19th April. All riders are to be mounted. A Medallion will be presented to every rider competing in the event, at the Presentation of Prizes.

THE ENDURANCE PHASE

The Steeplechase course will consist of 5 fences and cover a distance of approximately 1100 metres.

- Section 1: Time for course calculated at 600 m per minute.
 Section 2: Time for course calculated at 550 m per minute.
 Section 3: Time for course calculated at 500 m per minute.

ROADS and TRACKS: All Sections will cover a course of approx. 4100 metres at 240 m per minute.

CROSS COUNTRY COURSE: See the plan. This course will consist of fixed fences varying in height from 0.91 m to 0.76 m, depending on the Section.

The length of the course will be:

- Section 1: Approx. 2900 metres at a speed of 460 m per minute.
 Section 2: Approx. 2800 metres at a speed of 380 m per minute.
 Section 3: Approx. 2600 metres at a speed of 380 m per minute.

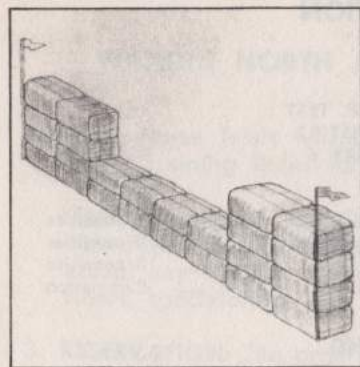
