WANDIN PARK HORSE TRIALS

- These Horse Trials will be conducted under the E.F.A. Combined Training Rules for Horse Trials 1980 and the amendments since that date.
- QUALIFICATION.** All owners and riders must be members of the Equestrian Federation of Australia and riders must be aged 17 or over on the date of the competition. All horses must be 15 hands high or over and 4 years of age or over. The Novice section is for grades III + IV horses and the Restricted Novice section for grade IV horses with less than five points.

- LIABILITY.** Neither the Organising Committee nor the Equestrian Federation of Australia accept any liability for any accidents, damage, injury to horses, owners, riders, grooms, officials, spectators, ground or any other person or property whatsoever.

- RESERVATION.** The organisers reserve the right

- to cancel any class or event
- to divide any class
- to alter the advertised times
- to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason
- alter the horses class within its grading
- to combine any classes

- FORBIDDEN ASSISTANCE.** Outside assistance is forbidden, under penalty of elimination. Any intervention by a third party, whether solicited or not, with the object of facilitating the task of the rider or helping his horse, is considered forbidden assistance. Similarly it is forbidden for a competitor to join or accept a lead from another.

It is forbidden for a jump judge or official to call back or assist a competitor by directions to rectify an error of course.

Catching a loose horse, helping the rider to adjust his saddlery or to remount after a fall is permitted. In such a case, the course must be resumed at the exact spot at which it was interrupted.

Whether or not a competitor has received forbidden assistance will be decided by the E.F.A. Steward.

- All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.

- PRESENTATION OF PRIZES.** The prizegiving will take place at the conclusion of the event. All placegetters must present themselves correctly attired and mounted for presentation of prizes.

CROSS COUNTRY

THE COURSE. See the plan. Fences are fixed and do not exceed 1.10 m in the Novice and 0.9 m in the Restricted Novice. The length of the Novice course is 3250 metres, and the length of the Restricted Novice course is 2800 metres.

SPEED. The minimum time for completing the course is calculated at a speed of 500 metres per minute for the Restricted Novice class, and 525 metres per minute for the Novice class.

PENALTIES.

1st refusal, run out or circle of horse at a jump	20 penalty
2nd refusal, run out or circle of horse at same jump	40 penalty
3rd refusal, run out or circle of horse at same jump	Elimination
Fall of horse and/or rider at jump	60 penalties
Error of course not rectified	
Omission of obstacle or boundary flag	
Retaking an obstacle already jumped	Elimination
Jumping obstacle in wrong order	

These penalties are cumulative.

For every commenced period of 3 seconds in excess of the minimum Time	1 penalty
Exceeding the Time Limit	Elimination

ELIMINATION AND RETIRING. Competitors eliminated or retiring from any part of the course for any reason whatsoever shall do so at a walk and shall take every precaution to avoid disturbing other competitors. They shall not jump any fences after retiring.

SHOW JUMPING

The jumping test consists of one round, with obstacles no higher than 1.00 m for the Restricted Novice and 1.15 m for the Novice.

PENALTIES.

Knocking down an obstacle	5 penalties
1st disobedience (refusal etc.) of horse	5 penalties
2nd disobedience in whole test	10 penalties
3rd disobedience in whole test	Elimination
For every commenced period of 4 seconds in excess of time allowed	1 penalty

TIME. The time allowed is calculated at a speed of 300 metres per minute for the Restricted Novice, and 350 metres per minute for the Novice. The time limit is twice the time allowed.
