

- These Horse Trials will be conducted under the E.F.A. Combined Training Rules for Horse Trials 1983 and the amendments since that date.
- LIABILITY. Neither the Organising Committee nor the Equestrian Federation of Australia accept any liability for any accidents, damage, injury to horses, owners, riders, grooms, officials, spectators, ground or any other person or property whatsoever.
- 3. RESERVATION. The organisers reserve the right
  - (a) to cancel any class or event
  - (b) to divide any class
  - (c) to alter the advertised times
  - (d) to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason
  - (e) alter the horses class within its grading
  - (f) to combine any classes.

4. FORBIDDEN ASSISTANCE. Outside assistance is forbidden, under penalty of elimination. Any intervention by a third party, whether solicited or not, with the object of facilitating the task of the rider or helping his horse, is considered forbidden assistance. Similarly it is forbidden for a competitor to join or accept a lead from another.

It is forbidden for a jump judge or official to call back or assist a competitor by directions to rectify an error of course.

Catching a loose horse, helping the rider to adjust his saddlery or to remount after a fall is permitted. In such a case, the course must be resumed at the exact spot at which it was interrupted.

Whether or not a competitor has received forbidden assistance will be decided by the E.F.A. Steward.

- 5. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
