Wandin Park Horse Trials

This is the Fifth Annual Horse Trials Competition that the Committee has organised and it is becoming one of the most professionally run and prestigious Horse Trials competitions in Australia. Only the highest standards will be used in all phases of the competition, which can be seen already from the Cross Country course that has been built.

It is the aim of the Committee to increase public awareness and introduce as many people as possible to the exciting sport of eventing. The magnificent venue is close to Melbourne and right in the heart of a big tourist area which makes it ideal for the public to attend. It also provides the competitors with undulating country, creeks, dams and hills, all essential for "testing" the horse and rider. We would welcome any suggestions that you might have to improve the event and thank you for supporting today with your attendance.

General Conditions WANDIN PARK HORSE TRIALS

1. These Horse Trials will be conducted under the E.F.A. Combined Training Rules for Horse Trials 1983 and the amendments since that date.
2. **LIABILITY.** Neither the Organising Committee nor the Equestrian Federation of Australia accept any liability for any accidents, damage, injury to horses, owners, riders, grooms, officials, spectators, ground or any other person or property whatsoever.
3. **RESERVATION.** The organisers reserve the right
 - (a) to cancel any class or event
 - (b) to divide any class
 - (c) to alter the advertised times
 - (d) to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason
 - (e) alter the horses class within its grading
 - (f) to combine any classes.
4. **FORBIDDEN ASSISTANCE.** Outside assistance is forbidden, under penalty of elimination. Any intervention by a third party, whether solicited or not, with the object of facilitating the task of the rider or helping his horse, is considered forbidden assistance. Similarly it is forbidden for a competitor to join or accept a lead from another.
It is forbidden for a jump judge or official to call back or assist a competitor by directions to rectify an error of course.
Catching a loose horse, helping the rider to adjust his saddlery or to remount after a fall is permitted. In such a case, the course must be resumed at the exact spot at which it was interrupted.
Whether or not a competitor has received forbidden assistance will be decided by the E.F.A. Steward.
5. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
6. **PRESENTATION OF PRIZES.** The prizegiving will take place at the conclusion of the event. All placegetters must present themselves correctly attired and mounted for presentation of prizes.
