# WANDIN PARK HORSE TRIALS

The Wandin Park Event is an all-round test of horse and rider.

There are three phases to the competition: Dressage, Cross-Country and Show-Jumping, each requiring skills of thorough training, precision and boldness.

The entire competition is scored on a penalty point basis with the horse and rider scoring the lowest number of penalty points winning.

There are three different classes for horses competing at Wandin Park. The class entered depends on the horse's past performance. The classes are Restricted Novice, Novice, and Advanced. Whilst Wandin Park Horse Trials provides a testing challenge for all horses, the degree of difficulty of the overall competition increases with each class.

## DRESSAGE

The Dressage Test, lasting approximately 6 minutes, is conducted on Saturday, although a demonstration will be conducted in the main area at 10.15am and 11.45am today.

In the Dressage Test a series of movements are executed and each one is marked by the judges, together with marks for general performance. During the Dressage Test the judges look for the horse to move eagerly and energetically forward whilst remaining responsive to the rider's direction. The penalty points incurred in the Dressage are carried forward to the Cross-Country and Show-Jumping phases.

Advanced — E.F.A. Test 3.1

## CROSS-COUNTRY

Wandin Park has three separate Cross-Country courses, one for each section of competition. There are 20 fences in the Restricted Novice, 22 in the Novice, and 24 in the Advanced Section. Penalties can be incurred in a number of ways.

PENALTIES: 1st Refusal, run out or circle of horse at a jump .....	20 penalties
2nd Refusal, run out or circle of horse at same jump .....	40 penalties
3rd Refusal, run out or circle of horse at same jump .....	ELIMINATION
Fall of horse and/or rider at jump .....	60 penalties
Error of course not rectified .....	ELIMINATION
Omission of obstacle or boundary flag .....	ELIMINATION
Re-taking of an obstacle already jumped .....	ELIMINATION
Jumping obstacle in wrong order .....	ELIMINATION
For every commenced period of 3 seconds in excess of the time allowed .....	1 penalty
Exceeding the time limit .....	ELIMINATION

Competitors in the Novice and Advanced Sections must carry 75kg in the Cross-Country phase.

## SHOW-JUMPING

The jumping test consists of one round with obstacles no higher than 1.15m for Restricted Novice and Novice, and 1.20m for the Advanced horses. Again penalties can be incurred.

PENALTIES: Knocking down an obstacle .....	5 penalties
1st disobedience (refusal etc.) of horse .....	5 penalties
2nd disobedience in whole test .....	10 penalties
3rd disobedience in whole test .....	ELIMINATION
For every commenced period of 1 second in excess of time allowed .....	25 penalty

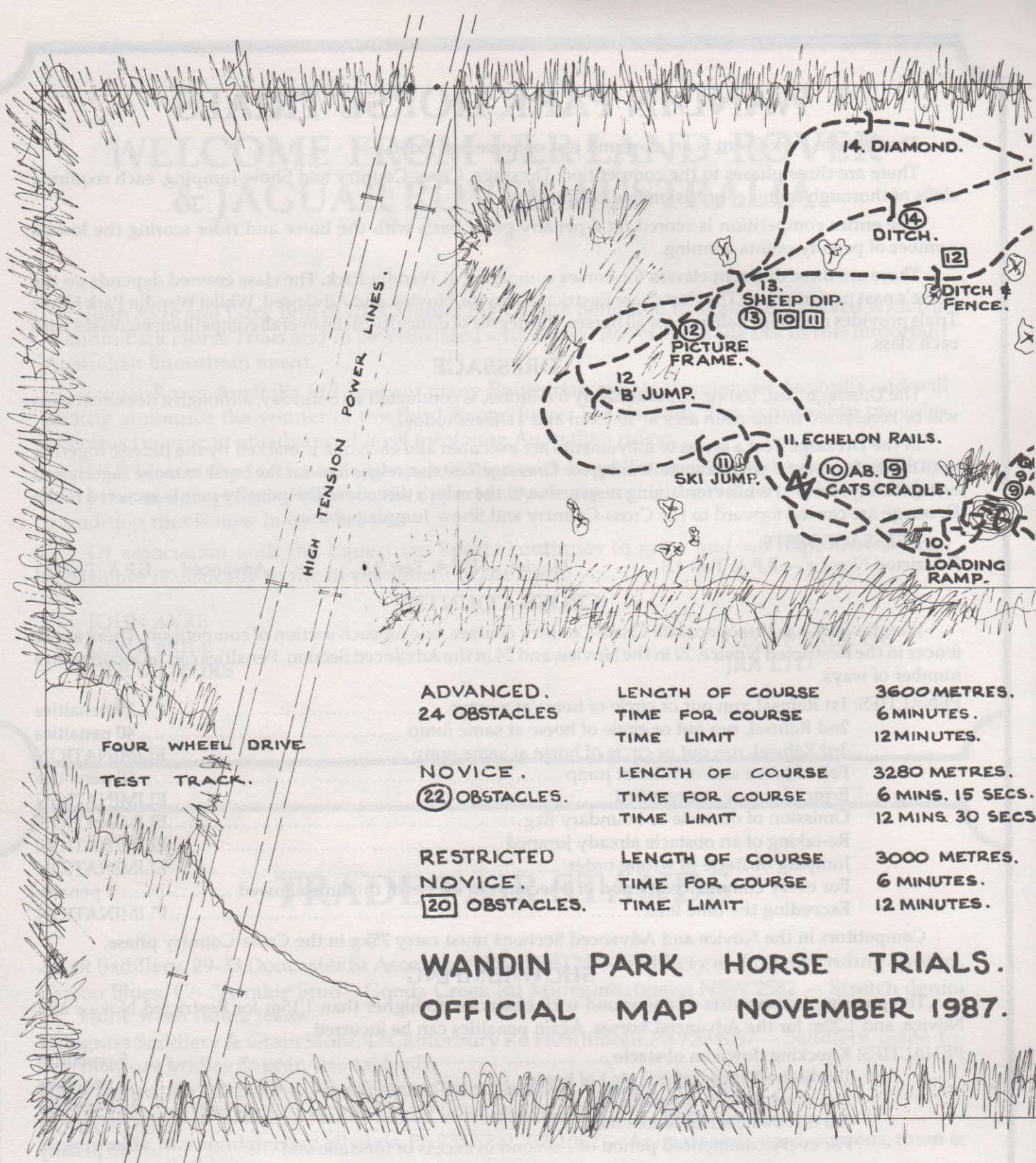

- These Horse Trials will be conducted under the E.F.A. Combined Training Rules for Horse Trials 1983 and the amendments since that date.
- LIABILITY.** Neither the Organising Committee nor the Equestrian Federation of Australia accept any liability for any accidents, damage, injury to horses, owners, riders, grooms, officials, spectators, ground or any other person or property whatsoever.
- RESERVATION.** The organisers reserve the right
  - to cancel any class or event
  - to divide any class
  - to alter the advertised times
  - to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason
  - to alter the horse's class within its grading
  - to combine any classes.
- FORBIDDEN ASSISTANCE.** Outside assistance is forbidden, under penalty of elimination. Any intervention by a third party, whether solicited or not, with the object of facilitating the task of the rider or helping his horse, is considered forbidden assistance. Similarly it is forbidden for a competitor to join or accept a lead from another. It is forbidden for a jump judge or official to call back or assist a competitor by directions to rectify an error of course. Catching a loose horse, helping the rider to adjust his saddlery or to remount after a fall is permitted. In such a case, the course must be resumed at the exact spot at which it was interrupted. Whether or not a competitor has received forbidden assistance will be decided by the E.F.A. Steward.
- All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- PRESENTATION OF PRIZES.** The prizegiving will take place at the conclusion of the event. All placegetters must present themselves correctly attired and mounted for presentation of prizes.

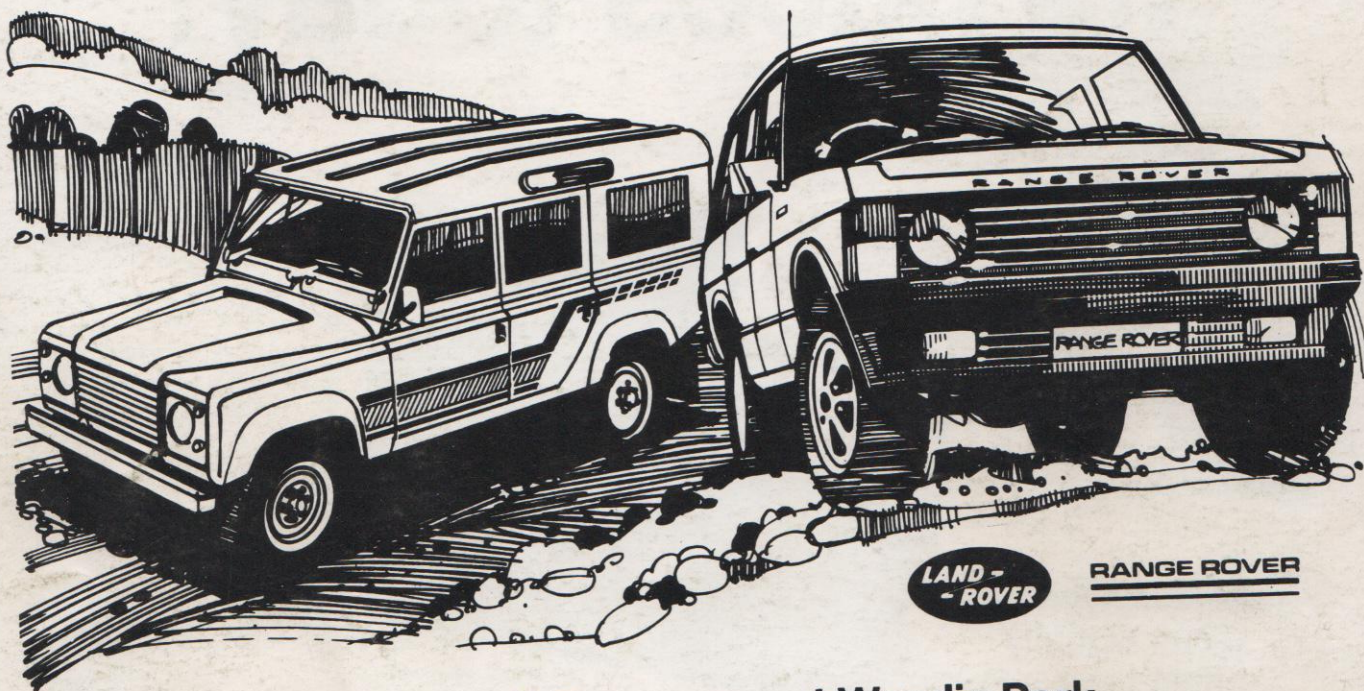
