## **Pony Club Team Games Championships:**

There is plenty of action to be seen when the teams from Cannibal Creek, Upper Yarra, Warragul, Doongala and Wyena compete for the Noble Perpetual Trophy. There will be four races - Bending, Flag and Barrel, Bat and Relay and Ride and Lead. These are the five finalists of competitions between Pony Clubs around the zone. Action starts at 12.30 pm in the main arena.

## **FEI Quadrille:**

## **Cross Country Runners:**

A popular event each year at Wandin Park is the race around the Restricted Novice Cross Country course by members of the Victorian Cross Country League. This year we are making it a bit harder with the runners competing over the Advanced course! Over the jumps and through the water - whatever the horses do, so too do the cross country runners. The race starts at 1.00pm immediately following the Advanced horses.

## **Saddle-Up Young Event Horse Trophy:**

This is our event to encourage breeders and trainers developing event horse of the future. The details of the competition are completely covered on the next page, but competitors are judged in sections covering dressage, jumping, conformation and a show of paces. Initial judging takes place on Saturday with the top eight horses being presented in the final competition on Sunday. This event is conducted throughout the day in the main arena.

## **7-Eleven Shetland Grand National:**

A hotly contested race for our young riders on their Shetland ponies. Months of training go into the preparation of these horses. The jumps consist of hay bales and the 'race track' is around the main arena. Come and see the action at 1.30pm.

## **Sky Divers:**

At 3.00pm four members of the Victorian Parachute Council will be jumping from 4000ft. and free falling to 2500 ft. during which time they will reach a speed of 160kmh. The lead parachutists will carry smoke flares and they will make their landing in the main arena.

## **Parade of Breeds:**

Irish Sport Horse, Warmblood, Arab, Thoroughbred, Clydesdale and many more. Fine examples of breeds will be paraded in the main arena at 1.15 and 3.00pm. You can also visit the horses at their stalls in the Country Fair and obtain more information about each breed.

## **Freestyle Skiing Aerial Show:**

A little unusual for Horse Trials - but just across the road from the Novice Sleeper Wall fence, is the largest artificial ski jump in the world. Throughout the day there will be non-stop action with some of Australia's best skiers, including Kirstie Marshall. The skiers wear regular skis and ski boots as they run down the synthetic slope, complete their aerials and land in the lake at the bottom of the run. Not for the faint hearted!

## **Retriever Dog Displays:**

Before and after the Advanced Cross Country, members of the K.C.C. and their dogs will put on a "non-slip retrieving display" at the Land Rover Lake. Watch these superbly trained dogs retrieve their 'quarry' from the water.

## **Yarra Glen & Lilydale Hunt Club Parade of Horses & Hounds:**

Working the hounds today are members of the Club led by the Master, Leo Mooney M.F.H. together with the Huntsman, Mr Nick Boulton. The club currently run 40 couples of English Foxhound based at their property at Yering. The club began in 1900 and currently has a membership of 130. Before the hounds are taken for some exercise on the Cross Country Course at 3.30pm there will be plenty of opportunity to get a closer look when they parade in the main arena at 3.15pm.

## **Tentpegging:**

In the main arena at 1.45 pm four teams from Toyota Yea, Iseki Rochester, McKinnon Lancers Bendigo and O'Dwyers Rochester will compete in the spectacular sport of Tentpegging. Tentpegging has its origins in the Boer War where an army would ride up to the enemy camp at night spearing the tent pegs causing the tents to collapse. The enemy would be trapped and easy prey for the infantry. Tentpegging is a combat tactic sport which requires military drill and precision.

## **Advanced Dressage:**

This year with both New Zealand and Australian teams competing in the Australian One Day Event Championships, we will present the team competitors dressage at 9.00am in the main arena.

Judges for the Advanced Dressage are:

Miss Judy Bradwell (UK)

Mrs Gillian Handford

Miss Bradwell has ridden for Britain on numerous occasions and her eventing successes include wins at Burghley, Chatsworth and Punchestown. She has enjoyed a distinguished career and is an acknowledged international judge.

## **Pal Super Dogs:**

Pal Super Dogs were formed in 1984. The team of 12 dogs give an outstanding display of agility and jumping. They compete over a series of obstacles incurring 'faults' similar to showjumping. From the German Shepherd to the Cairns Terrier Cross, these canines are great crowd pleasers. Look for them in the main arena at 12 noon.

## THE SADDLE - UP YOUNG EVENT HORSE TROPHY

First introduced to Wandin Park in 1989, this event has been run successfully throughout the U.K., with the finals held at Burghley each year. The event is designed to recognise and encourage breeders and trainers in producing the correct type of young horse that is considered to be the best material to make a top eventing horse.

The class is open to 4 and 5 year olds and the competition is divided into four sections with a different judge for each section.

A qualifying heat is judged on Saturday with competitors completing the first sections of the competition.

### SECTION 1: DRESSAGE Judge - Miss Mary Longdon - 25% of score

Unlike a normal dressage test the judge does not assess individual movements and the judge may stand anywhere to be able to get the best view. The judge is looking at the potential of the horse and must discount the effect of the rider. Three correct, elastic and regular gaits through a swinging back are what is sought.

### SECTION 2: JUMPING Judge - Mr Michael Creber - 25% of score

The competitors proceed straight from the dressage ring into the jumping phase with only enough time to adjust stirrup length. Again, the judge is looking for potential and normal showjumping penalties do not apply. A horse with a fence down through inexperience may score higher than a weak horse that may rattle three, but jump clear.

### SECTION 3: MOVEMENT IN HAND Judge - Mr Brian Schrapel - 25% of score

The judge is looking at the conformation and movement of the horse.

### SECTION 4: FINAL JUDGING Judge - Mr Tad Coffin (U.S.A. - Olympic Gold Medallist) 25% of score

The highest placing six horses up to the end of section 3 are asked to show their paces, including the gallop, in the main arena.

# INTRODUCTION TO HORSE TRIALS

Wandin Park Horse Trials is a One Day Event. In the world of eventing there are also Two Day and Three Day events.

There are three phases of competition in a One Day Event: Dressage, Cross Country and Showjumping, each requiring skills of thorough training, precision and boldness.

The horse must demonstrate the controlled discipline of the dressage test, yet be bold and possess the stamina to jump over 20 fences across 3km of the cross country course. He must then be able to show sufficient suppleness after the endurance test to complete a showjumping round cleanly.

The entire competition is scored on a penalty point basis with the horse and rider scoring the lowest number of penalty points winning the competition.

There are four different "classes" or levels of competition at Wandin Park Horse Trials.

The classes are: •JUNIOR •RESTRICTED NOVICE  
•NOVICE •ADVANCED

The class entered depends on the horse's past performance with performance or grading points being accumulated with each placing in a competition. This ensures that horses with similar performances compete against each other.

## DRESSAGE

In the Dressage test a series of set movements are executed and each one is marked by the judges, together with marks for general performance. During the dressage test, the judges look for the horse to move eagerly and energetically forward whilst remaining responsive to the rider's direction.

The dressage test is ridden in an arena 60 x 20 metres and the test must be executed from memory.

### DRESSAGE TESTS

Junior EFA Test 1D Restricted Novice: EFA Test 1D  
Novice: EFA Test 2E Advanced: EFA Test 3E

The penalty points incurred in the dressage are carried forward to the cross country and showjumping phases.

## CROSS COUNTRY

Wandin Park has three separate courses, one for each section of competition. There are 22 fences in the Restricted Novice and Junior, 22 in the Novice, and 24 in the Advanced section. Penalties can be incurred in a number of ways.

### PENALTIES:

1st refusal, run out or circle of horse at a jump	20 penalties
2nd refusal, run out or circle of horse at same jump	40 penalties
3rd refusal, run out or circle of horse at same jump	Elimination
Fall of horse and/or rider at jump	60 penalties
Third fall of horse, and/or rider at obstacle	Elimination
Error of course not rectified	Elimination
Omission of obstacle or boundary flag	Elimination
Re-taking of an obstacle already jumped	Elimination
Jumping obstacle in wrong order	Elimination
For every commenced period of 1 second in excess of time allowed	.4 penalty
Exceeding the time limit	Elimination

Competitors in the Novice and Advanced sections must carry 75kg in the cross country phase.

### What is a refusal?

A horse is considered to have a refusal if it stops in front of the obstacle to be jumped. A stop, followed immediately by a standing jump, is not penalised. The horse may step sideways but if the horse steps back even a single pace, voluntarily or not, or if the halt is prolonged, this constitutes a refusal.

If a horse that has already stepped back once, is re-presented at the obstacle and halts or steps back a second time, or if the halt is prolonged and the competitor redoubles or changes his effort, still without success, this constitutes a second refusal and so on.

## SHOWJUMPING

The jumping tests consists of one round with obstacles no higher than:

Junior & Restricted Novice: 1.15m  
Novice: 1.15m  
Advanced: 1.20m

The test must be carried out at the following speeds


Advanced: 400mpm  
Novice: 350mpm  
Restricted Novice: 300mpm

Penalties have been changed effective 1st January 1989, and are now as follows:

## CARRIAGE DRIVING CHAMPIONSHIP

In conjunction with Wandin Park Horse Trials, a Combined Driving Event will be staged on Saturday and Sunday. A Combined Driving Event consists of three elements of competition.

Competition A - Presentation and Dressage - Saturday 9.30am  
Competition B - Marathon - Sunday 10.30am  
Competition C - Obstacle Driving - Saturday following dressage

**Presentation:** The object of Presentation is to judge the turnout cleanliness, general condition of the horses, driver, grooms, harness and vehicle. Whilst it does not resemble a Show Turnout Class in minute attention to detail, the neatness and efficiency of all personnel should be taken into account and their dress should conform to the style of vehicle and harness.

**Dressage:** The object of the Dressage is to judge the freedom, regularity of paces, harmony and lightness, ease of movement, impulsion and correct positioning of horses on the move. The competitor will also be judged on his style of driving, accuracy and general command of his horse. Driver must carry his whip in hand. Multiples must carry a groom, singles, optional.

**Obstacle Driving (Cone Driving):** This part of the competition is designed to test the fitness, obedience and suppleness of the horse and skill of the driver. The combination are timed from the first part of the horse crossing the start and finish lines.

**Marathon:** This phase of the competition will start at 9.30 AM on Sunday. It will test the fitness and stamina of the horse. The marathon course is divided into five sections: A, C and E are completed at the trot. Sections B and D must be executed at the walk. At the end of Section B and D there is a 10 minute halt and also at D, a vet check. Section E includes 5 Marathon Obstacles or Hazards.

1. These Horse Trials will be conducted under the E.F.A Combined Training Rules for Horse Trials 1983 and the amendments since that date.

2. **LIABILITY.** Neither the Organising Committee nor the Equestrian Federation of Australia accept any liability for any accidents, damage, injury to horses, owners, riders, grooms, officials, spectators, ground or any other person or property whatsoever.

3. **RESERVATION.** The organisers reserve the right (a) to cancel any class or event (b) to divide any class (c) to alter the advertised times (d) to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason (e) to alter the horse's class within its grading (f) to combine any classes.

4. **FORBIDDEN ASSISTANCE.** Outside assistance is forbidden, under penalty of elimination. Any intervention by a third party, whether solicited or not, with the object of facilitating the task of the rider or helping his horse, is considered forbidden

assistance. Similarly it is forbidden for a competitor to join or accept a lead from another.

It is forbidden for a jump judge or official to call back or assist a competitor by directions to rectify an error of course.

Catching a loose horse, helping the rider to adjust his saddlery or to remount after a fall is permitted. In such a case, the course must be resumed at the exact spot at which it was interrupted.

Whether or not a competitor has received forbidden assistance will be decided by the E.F.A. Steward.

5. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.

6. **PRESENTATION OF PRIZES.** The prizegiving will take place at the conclusion of the event. All placegetters must present themselves correctly attired and mounted for presentation of prizes.



# THE TEAM CHALLENGE

Thank you **MILLARD PERSONNEL** for bringing the New Zealand team to Australia.

## NEW ZEALAND

## AUSTRALIA



**BLYTH TAIT** - The current World Champion, 30 year old Blyth Tait is based in the UK, and will be mounted on an Australian horse at these Championships. He is a Northlander, but lives in Pukekohe, south of Auckland, when in New Zealand.

Blyth captained the successful New Zealand team at the 1988 Bicentennial 3DE at Hawkesbury, NSW, placing second individually on Messiah, his gold medal mount, which was hand reared by owner Carol Byles near Whangarei.

They went to England the following year, and were second at Badminton in 1990. It has been a frustrating year for Blyth with setbacks to both Messiah and his back up horse Richochet. However he has had several British horses on which to compete, placing second to fellow Kiwi, Vicky Latta at the pre-Barcelona event in June riding Shady Lane, and was also second at Luhmühlen, Germany, riding Clarissa Bleekman's Delphy Dazzle. With support from the NZ Sports Foundation, Blyth has managed without a major sponsor to date, but cannot continue indefinitely without one. He has endeavoured to accept all invitations and fulfil all obligations as World Champion, proving to be a good ambassador for both his sport and his country.



**TRUDY BOYCE** - Riding Mossman, Trudy was the World Silver medallist at Gawler in 1986. Trudy placed second the previous year when the first Trans Tasman Trophy contest was also staged at Gawler. Selected in the 1988 Seoul Olympic team, Trudy faced the disappointment of Mossman going lame after arrival in Korea. She now has two promising

horses in the Olympic training squad, Van Gogh and Sea Law. Sea Law is an eleven year old, 16.3hh brown TB gelding by Beaufort Sea. Bred in the South Island, he was raced as a youngster, and then introduced to eventing by owner Sally Wigley. She took him through novice, then sent him North to Vaughn Jefferis, who rode him through Intermediate before going to England in 1990, at which stage Trudy took over the ride. However it was Vaughn who rode him to place at Taupo CCI in May, having accepted the ride at zero hour when Trudy was named in the Trans Tasman team on Van Gogh. Vaughn remarked what a great job Trudy had done on the horse in the eighteen months since he had ridden him.

Trudy 28, first represented New Zealand in 1984 when a Young Rider team won an international teams competition in Australia on borrowed horses. Her family are dairy farmers in Tokoroa, in the Waikato, and have bred two NZ 3DE winners - Kim on Odette in 1982 and Trudy on Mossman in 1984.



**MATTHEW GRAYLING** - A 28 year old sharemilker from Plymouth, Matthew is the current Caro Scholar, selected for training as a future New Zealand international, although they have already represented their country as members of the successful Trans Tasman team at Taupo in May.

Recently married to a fellow competitor, Matthew will be accompanied by his wife Susan on this trip.

Lochan Ora is a fourteen year old, 16.2 chestnut TB gelding by Sergeant Major out of Jedha. He was bred in the South Island and evented from there by veterinarian owner Nick Pyke, until Matthew took over the ride a year ago.



### ANDREW HOY -

Andrew is one of Australia's most outstanding eventing riders, having represented his country at three Olympic Games, three World Championship teams and on two Trans Tasman teams.

The Culcairn sheep and dairy farmer comes to the National One Day Event Championships at the Wandin Park Horse Trials fresh from his win with his mount Kiwi in the Advanced section of the Melbourne Three Day Event at Werribee making it his third win at this event.

Hoy won the Advanced title at Wandin Park last year with Kiwi. Hoy is the only Australian to be long listed for Barcelona with two mounts - the magnificent Kiwi and his less experienced but nonetheless exciting young mount Joe Gundy. Hoy placed eighth at the Seoul Olympics in 1988 and will ride Joe Gundy at Wandin Park this year.

He is an exceptionally skilled rider who likes to compete from the front of the pack. He is picture of consistency and a horseman in the true sense.



**WAYNE ROYCROFT** - Wayne is arguably one of the the best event riders Australia has ever produced. He has represented Australia at three Olympic games, Mexico, Los Angeles and Montreal picking up three bronze medals along the way.

Wayne with his grey mount Valdez was a member of the Australian bronze medal

winning team at the 1986 World Championships at Gawler. Wayne coached the Australian eventing team at the Seoul Olympic and he continues in his role as National coach.

He will ride the big bright bay, Kentucky Mariner at Wandin Park this year.

Kentucky Mariner is a successful Grand Prix showjumper that competes regularly in World Cup events and also performs a good dressage test. Wayne, who is married to showjumper Vicki, lives in Mount White, NSW.



**ELIZABETH MULHOLLAND** - Liz who comes from Belgrave South where she works her horses full time is a well credentialed young rider. Only 20 years old, Liz was victorious in the Wandin Junior Two Day Event Young Rider Championship in April on Windsong Skyway.

She won the 1989 Victorian Young Event Rider award and put in a consistent performance at the recent Melbourne Three Day Event to finish in 10th place with Captain Jack..

Riding her Advanced horse Captain Jack, Liz will join Andrew Hoy and Wayne Roycroft in the Australian team this year.


