THE TEAMS NEW ZEALAND



SARAH DRING (WOODBINE HONEST JOE)

This 20 year old riding instructor from Oxford, North Canterbury originates from the United Kingdom and has only been in New Zealand for a few years. Woodbine Honest Joe may be young, at seven, but he already has 48 grading points. This combination won the South Island Young Rider Three Day Event at McLeans Island last November, and have already placed second in a couple of open intermediate trials.



PAULINE JARVIS (ACE HIGH)






