THE TEAMS NEW ZEALAND



SARAH DRING (WOODBINE HONEST JOE)

This 20 year old riding instructor from Oxford, North Canterbury originates from the United Kingdom and has only been in New Zealand for a few years. Woodbine Honest Joe may be young, at seven, but he already has 48 grading points. This combination won the South Island Young Rider Three Day Event at McLeans Island last November, and have already placed second in a couple of open intermediate trials.



PAULINE JARVIS (ACE HIGH)

Pauline, 20, is a student at Canterbury University but lives at Christchurch to fulfill her equestrian interests. She has placed consistently with Ace High, an 11 year old mount with 32 grading points, in both young rider and open intermediate events.



KATE LAMBIE (TIMBERTOP)

Auckland-born Kate is the baby of the team at 17. While without experience at intermediate level, with Timbertop she won the Pukekohe Young Rider Three Day Event in December and placed second in the New Zealand novice Three Day Event at Taupo last May. Timbertop is 13 years old and on 37 grading points.



JO SCOTT (RUFUS)

Jo is a 19 year old Canterbury University student who lives in Rangiora, North Canterbury. Rufus is a 14 year old advanced grade horse with 94 grading points. Joe and Rufus represented New Zealand in the victorious 1990 Young Rider team in New Zealand. They were third in the Pukekohe Young Rider Three Day Event last December and won a couple of open intermediate trials last year.



KYLIE SPRAGUE (GLENFIDDICH)

Kylie, 20 from Whangarei, was the proud winner of the inaugural Blyth Tait scholarship. This award funds a Northland Young Rider to the United Kingdom for experience as a working pupil. She worked with Andrew Nicholson last year and has been offered a position at his stables this year. Glenfiddich is an 11 year old with 52 grading points earned mainly in Young Rider events.

THE TEAMS AUSTRALIA

KATE FARRELL (JABERWOCKY)

Kate is an 18 year old university student studying Environmental Science. Although she has been riding Jaberwocky for only 9 months, Kate has been placing consistently. 2nd at Darlington 3DE in December and 2nd at Yeringberg and Lilydale in the Grade 1 Pony Club section this year. Kate's other mount, Cobi, has been a successful mount for her now for many years.

VANESSA ROWE (JOYFUL GAMBLER)

Sponsored by Nufarm, Vanessa is currently a member of the Victorian Showjumping squad. She is 18 years old and studying to become a nurse. Vanessa's form on Joyful Gambler includes a 4th at Gawler 3DE Novice and 2nd at Melbourne Hunt Novice in 1991. After a recent injury, Joyful Gambler scored a first up 7th in the Advanced class at Melbourne Hunt ODE.

SYBIL ABBOTT (MUMPIEOWIE)

The Abbott family bred 'Mumpy' and Sybil, 19 has ridden him through Pony Club and into open competition. His name is taken from a family property in Queensland. In 1991 the combination won the Naracoorte 3DE and were part of the winning team at Pony Club State Championships. Sybil combines her riding with her university studies, where she is undertaking a Fine Arts course at Melbourne.

WENDY SCHAEFFER (SUNBURST)

Wendy, 17, comes from Hahndorf in South Australia and is no stranger to Wandin Park, having competed here successfully on many occasions.

This year Wendy has had two starts on Sunburst, running 2nd in the Intermediate at Wangaratta and last week she won the Advanced class at Camperdown. Her form last year was no less impressive with wins at Wirinna and Geelong. Wendy won the S.A. Young Event Rider award in 1991 and represented Australia in the Trans Tasman Team which toured New Zealand in 1990.

MICHELLE ATKINSON (RICH RETURN) — 1st Reserve

Michelle bought her now 8 year old grey mare 'Cinders' for only \$300 just 3 years ago. In 1991 she won Wandin Junior, won Wangaratta Novice, won Avenel Junior Novice and ran 4th at Wandin National Championships - Novice.

In 1990 Michelle and 'Cinders' were named winners of the Junior Rider & Horse Combination award.
