- PRESENTATION OF PRIZES:** The prizegiving will take place at the conclusion of the endurance phase on Sunday 30th March. All riders are to be mounted and dressed as for Dressage.

THE COMPETITION

ENDURANCE PHASE:

Phase A – Roads and Tracks: This will consist of 2200 metres course to be completed at 220 metres per minute. Time allowed for all sections is 10 minutes, with the time limit 12 minutes.

Time Penalty: For every commenced period of one second in excess of the minimum time 1 penalty

Phase B – Steeple Chase: This will be run over varying distances, depending on the class.

Pre-Novice Sections: 1200 metres Time Allowed 2 minutes

Championships and Novice: 1280 metres Time Allowed 2 minutes

Time Penalty: For every commenced period of one second in excess of the minimum time8 penalty

Phase C – Roads and Tracks: All sections will complete a course of 4400 metres at 220 metres per minute. Time allowed will be 20 minutes. Time Limit : 24 mins.

Time Penalty: For every commenced period of one second in excess of the minimum time 1 penalty

Phase D – Cross Country:

Please refer to the plan in the centre of the programme. This course will consist of fixed fences with the following details:

Elimination and Retiring:

Competitors eliminated or retiring from any part of the course for any reason whatsoever shall do so at a walk and shall take every precaution to avoid disturbing other competitors. They shall not jump any fences after retiring or elimination.
