For every commenced period of one second in excess of the

Elimination and Retiring:

Competitors eliminated or retiring from any part of the course for any reason whatsoever shall do so at a walk and shall take very precaution to avoid disturbing other competitors. They shall not jump any fences after retiring or elimination.


