1st refusal, run out or circle of a horse at a jump	20 penalties
2nd refusal, run out or circle of a horse at same jump.....	40 penalties
3rd refusal, run out or circle of a horse at same jump	elimination
Fall of horse and/or rider at a jump	60 penalties
Second fall of horse and/or rider	elimination
Error of course not rectified	elimination
Omission of obstacle or boundary flag	elimination
Retaking an obstacle when already jumped	elimination
Jumping obstacle in wrong order	elimination

These penalties are cumulative

For every commenced period of one second in excess of the optimum time4 penalty
Exceeding the time limit (twice the optimum time)	elimination

Elimination and Retiring:

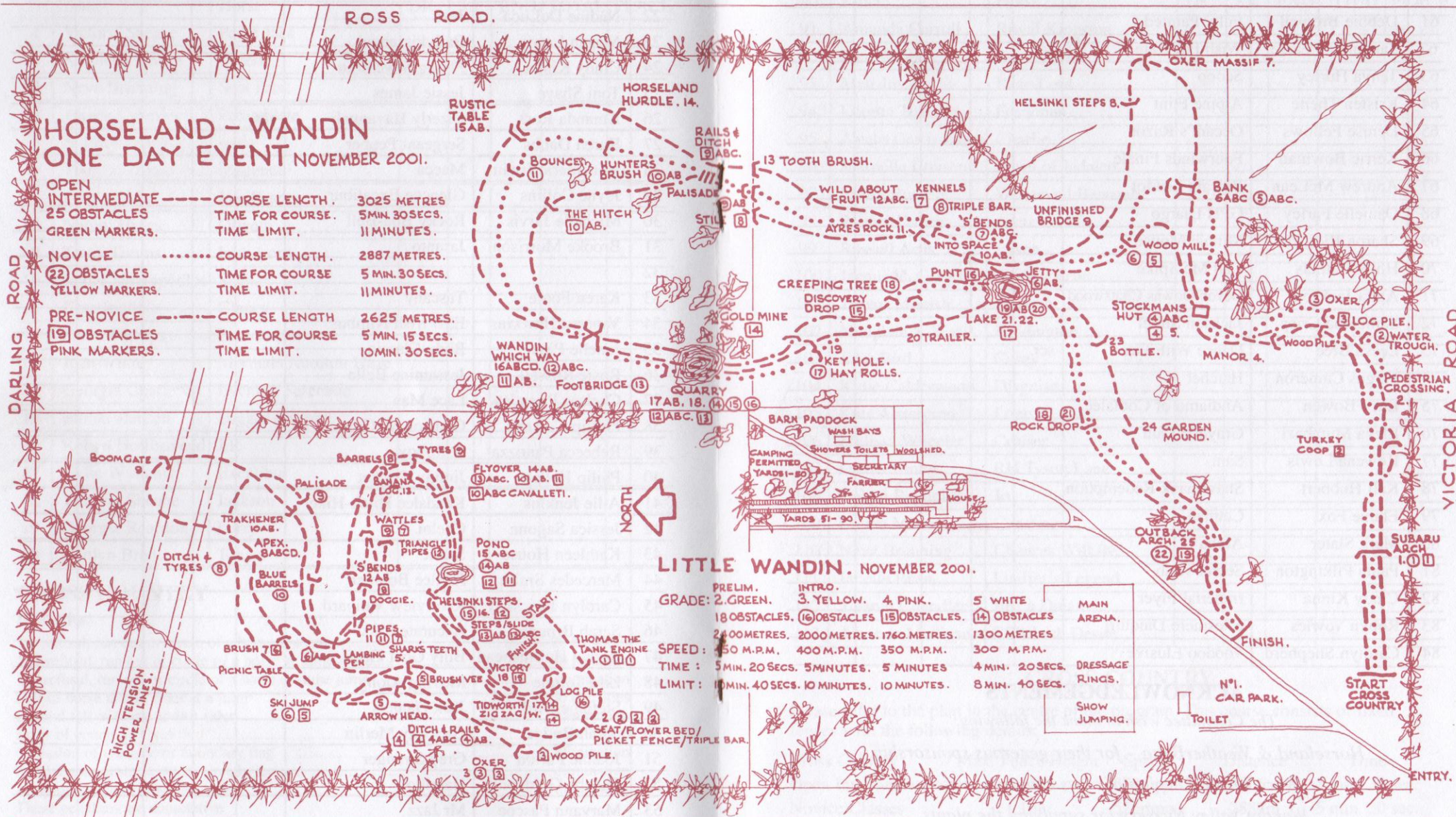
Competitors eliminated or retiring from any part of the course for any reason whatsoever shall do so at a walk and shall take very precaution to avoid disturbing other competitors. They shall not jump any fences after retiring or elimination.

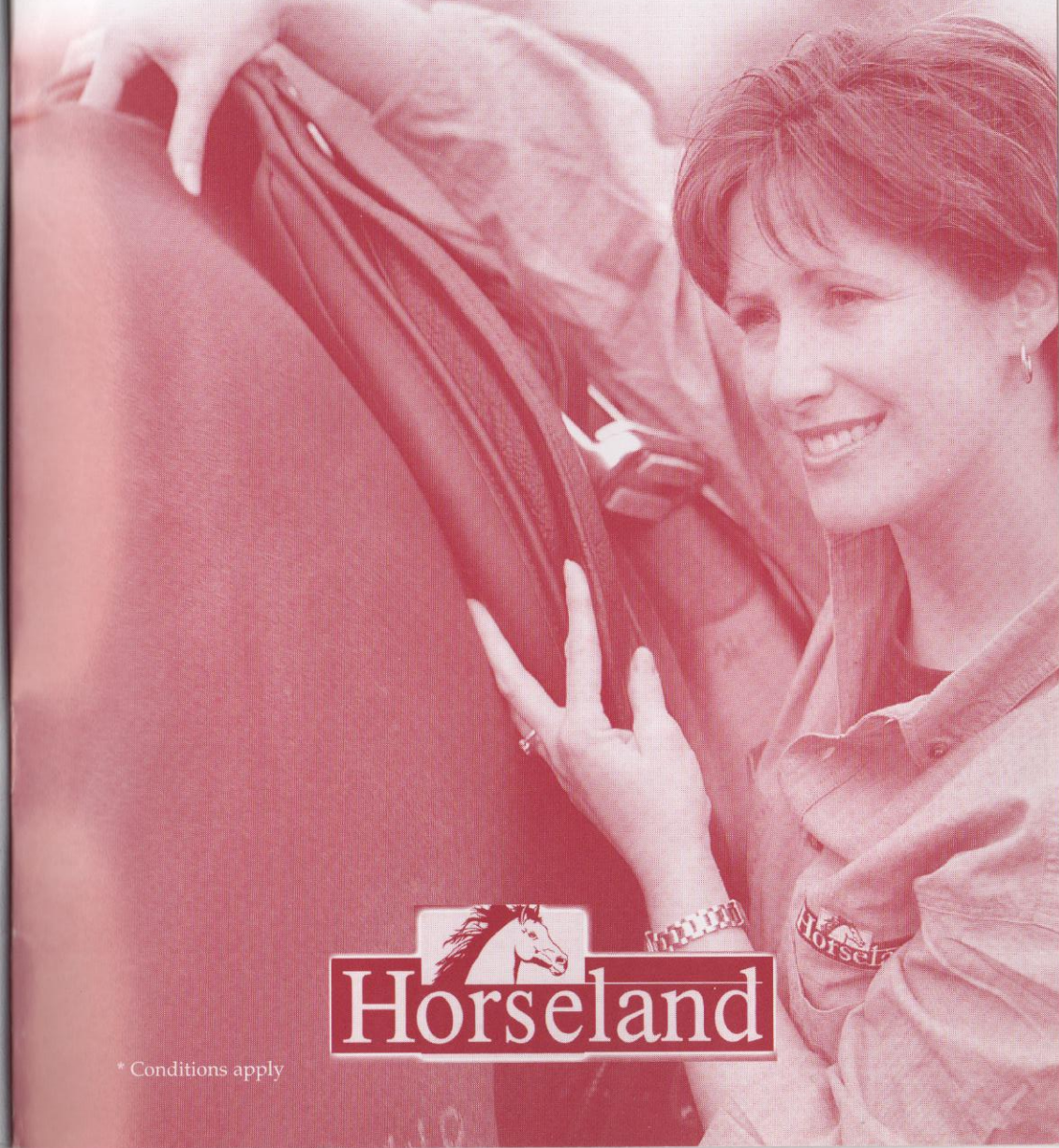
