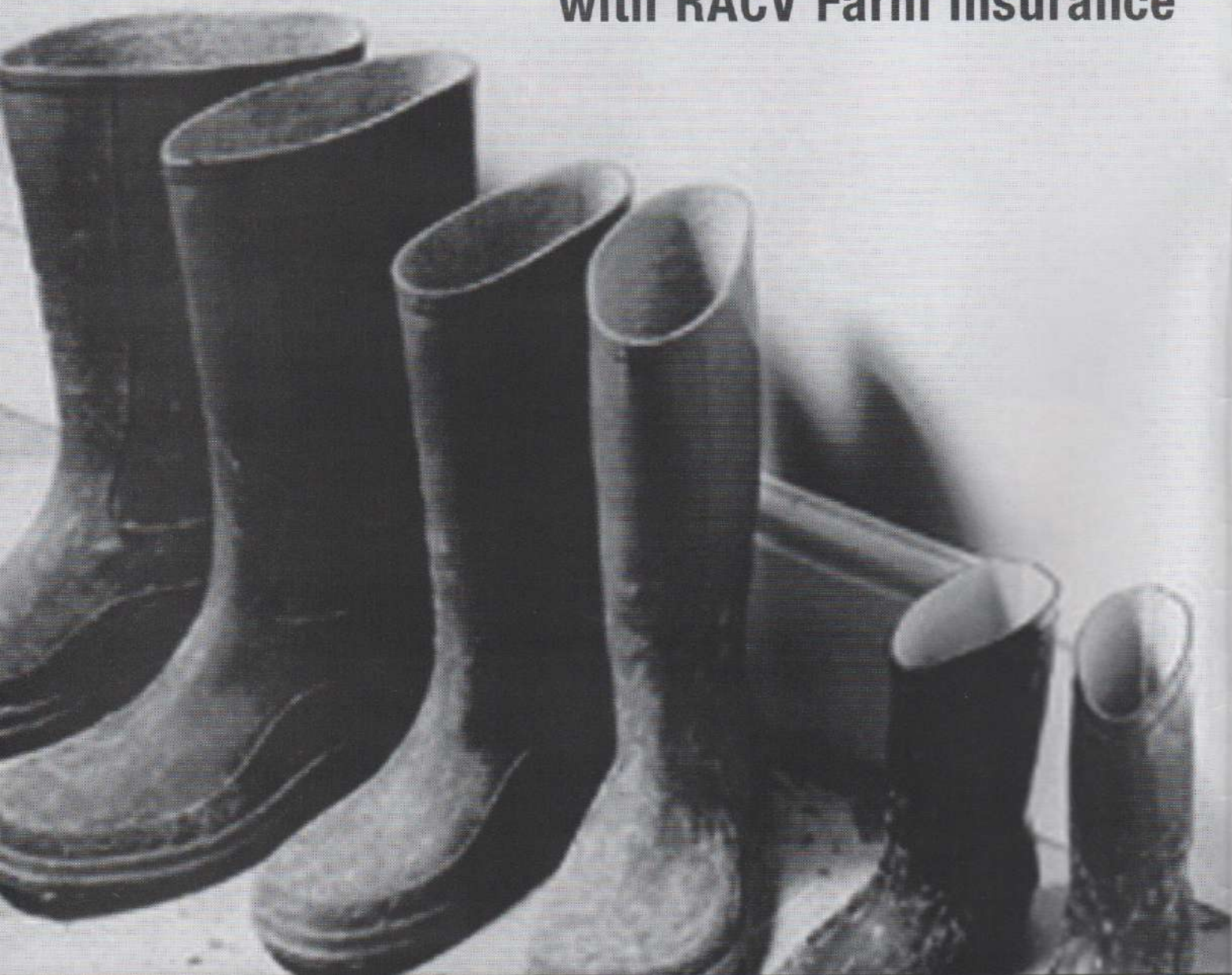

Got Protection

Our quality of life pivots on our ability to earn income. So what happens if you can't work for months? This is when income protection insurance can save your lifestyle.

Mid stream, the high-profile careers of Michael J. Fox and Christopher Reeves were cut short by unexpected events – Fox by a degenerative disease and Reeves as a result of a horse riding accident. You can't control the future but you can minimize the financial impacts of such shattering events.

Income-protection insurance is arguably the most important risk product there is because it covers your most valuable asset: your capacity to earn an income.

There are two main types of income insurance: agreed value policies, which dominate the market: and older-style indemnity products.

Income-protection insurance also referred to income replacement, disability income and salary continuance – usually replaces up to 75% of your income if you are unable to work because of illness or injury.

With an agreed value policy, the benefit level is set at the time the contract is taken out and guaranteed at that level so there are no arguments about it later even if your income subsequently drops.

With an indemnity product your benefit is based on your income at the time of claim, irrespective of the amount you have insured for and paid for.

Why You Need Income Protection

Sick leave is limited and workers compensation covers you only for work-related disabilities, which are small in number compared with disability claims.

Many people don't understand what arrangements they have with their employers. It is important to check before you take out the insurance. The other question is super- some super plans offer income protection cover but is usually limited to two years.

Without an income you can't put food on the table, pay the mortgage, service your debts or pay your bills.

You may suffer a temporary illness that allows you to go back to work or you may suffer something more serious, such as a stroke, kidney failure or multiple sclerosis etc.

Battling a serious illness or injury is bad enough, without having to worry where your money is going to come from. If you aren't able to work it's a massive problem because you have to eat into your savings and possibly sell your home. It becomes almost impossible to recover financially.

It is by far the most important insurance there is. The income you earn over a lifetime will exceed a million dollars and without that your lifestyle and that of your dependants cannot be sustained or improved.

What Is The Cost

Premiums are based on several factors including your age, health, gender, whether you smoke, your occupation, the waiting period and the benefit period.

The Importance Of Good Advice

If you deal direct with the insurance company you pay the same premium. You are not getting it any cheaper compared with getting advice. Ask the advisor why he/she is recommending a particular policy; ask for the definition on total and partial disability and how that would affect your ability to claim under that policy. Ask what the advisors business background and experience is.

WELFARE OF THE HORSE CODE OF CONDUCT

- In all equestrian sports the horse must be considered paramount.
- The well being of the horse shall be above the demands of breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organisers, sponsors or officials.
- All handling and veterinary treatment must ensure the health and welfare of the horse.
- The highest standards of nutrition, health, sanitation and safety shall be encouraged and maintained at all times.
- Adequate provision must be made for ventilation, feeding, watering and maintaining a healthy environment during transportation.
- Emphasis should be placed on increasing education in training and equestrian practices and on promoting scientific studies in equine health.
- In the interests of the horse, the fitness and competence of the rider shall be regarded as essential.
- All riding and training methods must take into account of the horse as a living entity and must not include any technique considered by the FEI to be abusive.
- National Federations should establish adequate controls in order that all persons and bodies under their jurisdiction respect the welfare of the horse.
- The National and International Rules and Regulations in equestrian sport regarding the health and welfare of the horse must be adhered to not only during National and International events, but also in training. Competition Rules and Regulations shall be continually reviewed to ensure such welfare.

HORSE TRIALS

The Wandin Park Horse Event is a one day event held over two days. In the world of eventing, there are also two and three day events.

A one day event has three phases of competition: dressage, showjumping and cross country. Each requires precision, boldness, and skills acquired by thorough training,

The horse must demonstrate controlled discipline in the dressage test, yet possess the stamina to jump many cross country fences placed over a distance of approximately 3km. The horse must then be able to show sufficient suppleness after the endurance test to complete a clear showjumping round.

The competition is scored on a penalty point basis, the horse and rider with the least penalty points wins.

Six classes will be contested at the Wandin Park Horse Event 2003. The classes are: CIC***/**/, Pre Novice, Junior Pre Novice and the LIVAMOL Young Event Horse. Horses are eligible to compete in each class depending on the number of qualifying competitions achieved the horse has accumulated in recent competitions. This ensures that horses of similar performance compete against each other.

Dressage

In the dressage test a series of movements are executed. Each movement is marked by the judges. Marks are also given for the general performance of the test. During the test, the judges look for the horse that is moving eagerly forward whilst remaining responsive to the rider's direction.

Dressage test are ridden in a 20 x 60m arena. The rider must execute the test from memory.

Penalty points accumulated in dressage are carried forward to the cross country and showjumping phases.

Cross Country

Wandin Park has four separate cross country courses originally designed by Captain Mark Phillips and Mike Etherington - Smith (the designer of the Sydney 2000 Olympic course). In the Pre Novice there are 25 jumping efforts over 18 cross country jumps. In the Novice there are 30 efforts over 22 fences, the Intermediate there are 33 efforts over 26 fences, and in the CIC*** there are 40 efforts over 26 fences.

Showjumping

The showjumping test consists of one round.

The maximum height of obstacles, and the average speed necessary to complete the round within the allowed time, are as follows for each class :

CIC*	Height - 1.10m	Speed - 350m/min

LIVAMOL YOUNG EVENT HORSE Section 1

The Young Event Horse class was first introduced to Wandin Park in 1989. The event is designed to recognise and encourage breeders and trainers who produce the type of young horse that is considered to be that which will make a top eventing horse. The class is open to 4 and 5 year old horses. The competition is divided into four sections. Each section has a different judge, and 25% of the total available marks are awarded in each section.

- Section 1 – Conformation, Saturday 9.45am, 'Red Menage'. Judge – Mr Peter Heagney
The Competitor performs an in-hand work pattern. The Judge is assessing aspects of conformation, overall balance, athleticism and trainability of the Event Horse. Scores will be allocated to each of these aspects.
- Section 2 – Dressage, Saturday 1.00pm, Ring 7. Judge – Ms Jill Sinclair. A simple dressage test will be ridden in a 60 x 20m arena. The Judge will not mark individual movements, but will consider the overall performance of the horse. The Judge will also take into account the rider's influence on the horse's performance as it is the horse's not the rider's potential they are looking for. The horse should produce three correct, elastic and regular gaits through a swinging back.
- Section 3 – Showing of Paces, Saturday 1.15pm. Judge – Ms Mary-Jane Crabtree.
All horses are to be ridden and will be judged on their paces (including the gallop) and jumping a small cross-country (a single log). The judge will score this section based on paces suitable for eventing.
- Section 4 – Showjumping, Sunday 8.00am, Main Arena. Judge – Ms Olivia Bunn. The jumping test is over a short course of about seven show jumping fences, no more than 90cm high. The test is designed to assess the horse's overall jumping performance and the judge will score on this basis, rather than conventional jumping penalties. A horse which knocks a fence down through inexperience may score higher than a horse with poor technique that jumps clear.

Conditions – Wandin Park Horse Trials

- 1 These horse trials will be conducted under the FEI/EFA official rules for horse trials 1999, and any amendments since that date.
- 2 Neither the Organising Committee, the Wandin Park Association or the EFA accept any liability for any accidents, damage, injury to horses, owners, riders, grooms, officials, spectators, ground or any other person or property whatsoever.
- 3 The organisers reserve the right to (a) cancel any class or event (b) divide any class (c) alter the advertised times (d) refuse any entry with or without providing a reason (e) alter a horse's class within it's grading (f) combine any classes.
- 4 Outside assistance is forbidden under penalty of elimination. Any intervention by a third party, whether solicited or not, with the object of facilitating the task of the rider or helping his horse, is considered forbidden assistance. Similarly, it is forbidden for a competitor to join or accept a lead from another. It is forbidden for a jump judge or official to call back or assist a competitor by directions to rectify an error of course. Catching a loose horse, helping the rider to adjust their saddlery, or to remount after a fall, is permitted. In such cases, the course must be resumed at the exact place at which it was interrupted. Whether or not a competitor has received forbidden assistance will be decided by the EFA steward.
- 5 All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- 6 The prize giving will take place at the conclusion of the event. All placegetters from all classes must present themselves correctly attired and unmounted for the presentation of prizes.

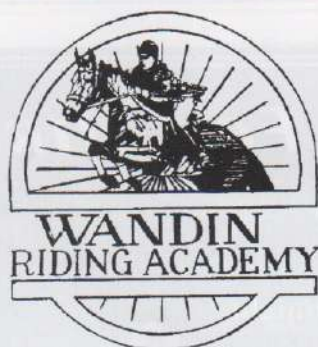
